etc. based on their experience from Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya


Dalgaon. The survey was conducted from 03-05-2023 to 02-06-2023 though feedback using


Google form. An online questionnaire was provided to the students which had a total of 6

The finding of the survey is presented below:










ALUMNI FEEDBACK FORM 2022-2023
