
#### **TEACHER FEEDBACK REPORT**







### **Concluding Remarks:**

The feedback from teachers provides valuable insights into their satisfaction with the college's academic environment. However, 11.4% of teachers disagree that the classrooms are clean and hygienic, and another 11.4% disagree that students are regular in class. Additionally, 5.7% feel that online attendance is not effective, while 3.2% report that the laboratory infrastructure is insufficient for conducting all required experiments. Furthermore, teachers have expressed concerns about the need for improvements in various infrastructures, including the library, computer laboratory, ICT tools, and faculty rooms. Many faculty members have highlighted the lack of adequate infrastructure for the arts faculty, as well as the need for almirahs and desktops in the department. There is also a demand for a generator, more sweepers, and better access to drinking water.
